DESCRIPTION

Concrete Profiler™ is a penetrating concentrated de-scale and surface renovator that quickly penetrates and dissolves lime deposits, mortar, scale, rust, algae, stains and mineral deposits. Concrete Profiler™ is the safe substitute for muriatic acid. Use Concrete Profiler™ to remove excess concrete and lime scale from new brick, and tile; to prepare masonry and floor surfaces for staining; and to remove mud stains, rust, and corrosion deposits from concrete parking areas, driveways, walkways, and retaining walls. Concrete Profiler™ works quickly and effectively to dissolve the carbonates that hold scale and other deposits together. Slow, expensive hand scrubbing, scraping, chipping, or brushing are eliminated. Use Concrete Profiler™ full strength to remove scale from metal parts and equipment. Use Concrete Profiler™ diluted to remove mortar film, insoluble carbonates, oxides, and to prepare concrete for staining.

ADVANTAGES

APPLICATION

Plastic or polyethylene sprayers and buckets are recommended for application. Concrete Profiler™ may be applied by brush, dip or spray. (When spraying, use as coarse a pattern as possible to avoid inhalation of mist.) Allow to soak for several minutes, or until all bubbling and foaming is stopped. Agitate lightly with a brush or broom. Rinse the floor thoroughly using a 3500 psi pressure washer and allow it to dry. Repeat application may be necessary if heavy accumulations are present. **For acid staining surface preparation: dilute 1:1 with water. For heavily soiled areas, color seal and overlay preparation: use at full strength.**

Some types of stainless steel, chrome plating, porcelain on steel and polished decorative aluminum may be discolored. Test before using. **DO NOT** use on magnesium or zinc

(galvanized). **DO NOT** allow to contact plastic laminates unless tested first.

PRECAUTIONS

As with all cleaners protective gloves and goggles are recommended for added safety. **WARNING:** Harmful if swallowed, contains hydrogen chloride and hydrogen sulfonate in addition to penetrates and corrosion inhibitors. Corrosive to eyes and may irritate the skin. Goggles and protective clothing are recommended for maximum protection. If ingested: Do not induce vomiting. Drink two glasses of water or milk. Get immediate medical help. If in eyes: flush thoroughly with water for 15 minutes, lifting both eyelids. If irritation persists, Get medical help. If on skin: rinse thoroughly with water then soap and water. If irritation develops, get medical help. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse.
